Service Description

The (ABI:STR) Program is a statewide program funded by the Victorian Department of Human Services and is governed by the Disability Services Act (2006). It provides rehabilitation and support to people with severe to profound acquired brain injuries between the ages of 5 and 64 years, who are ineligible for compensation or other rehabilitation services. The program is provided through various community partners including case management agencies, community therapists (i.e. Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy and Speech Pathology) and therapy support agencies. The ABI:STR program is a goal-based and outcome-focused approach to extended rehabilitation and provides rehabilitation, aids and equipment. Acquired brain injury rehabilitation aims to assist clients to reach an optimal level of independent functioning consistent with their injuries and maintain this functional status to maximise inclusion and community participation.
